2015-2016 Grants

On January 26, 2016 the Foundation announced the 2016 Grants during the opening of the 20th Annual "Delta National Small Print Exhibition" hosted by the Bradbury Gallery.

Three of our members attended the event. Terry Carty, Tom Bishop and Richard Carvell.

The first grant was to the Bradbury Art Museum (BAM) in the amount of \$50,000. The second grant was to Dr. Anne Grippo for the AR Science Festival for \$4,250. The third and final grant was to Dr. Richard Grippo in the Biological Sciences Department for \$3,000 to study the Caribbean Coral Reef Fish.
