New signage was revealed in the Kays Foundation Boardroom at the Cooper Alumni Center on the Arkansas State University campus. The two displays focus on four eras of the Foundation's history. Board one describes the creation of the Kays Foundation by V.C. Kays, who also served as the founding president of the First District Agricultural School. The school evolved into Arkansas State College in 1933 and Arkansas State University in 1967. It also documents the land and buildings the Foundation donated to the fledgling college. The second display board depicts the faculty housing provided by the Foundation as incentive to help recruit professors to the institution, and also focuses on the current status of the Foundation as a charitable organization that supports Arkansas State University by providing competitive grants. Photos of the Pleasance, a garden trail envisioned by long-time executive director and son of V.C. Kays, V.H. "Bud" Kays, are also included.
